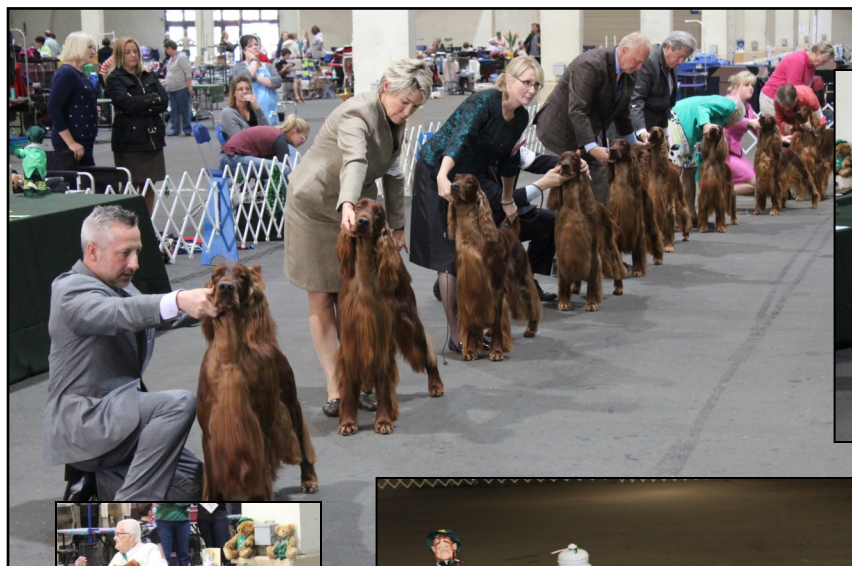

MAKE PLANS FOR ST. PATRICK'S PARADE



St. Patrick's Day Parade and Picnic

Saturday, March 16, 2013
Balboa Park, San Diego

"In the past, it has been warm so make sure your top priority is to keep the dogs comfortable"



We will all meet at the Alcazar Gardens parking lot between 8 and 8:30 am and have coffee and donuts available. This will also give us plenty of time to exercise the dogs and ready them for the parade. The parking lot fills up early, so plan accordingly. Please remember "pick-up" bags and also a water bottle or bucket for the dogs. (Weather can be unpredictable – hot, cold, rainy or in-between!) If the weather appears it is going to be warm, you can freeze cubes or cakes beforehand to carry in a small bucket. The water will stay cool longer and not spill.

Directions:

Take I-5 or 163 south to Park Avenue exit. Go north to Presidents Way, turn left in the park to the stop sign. Turn right, and go all the way past the Organ Pavilion to the end of the street. Go around the traffic circle, back towards the way you came, and make the first right into Alcazar Gardens parking lot.

Immediately following the parade we'll meet back at the parking lot and have a picnic in the Alcazar Flower Gardens. The club will supply the main dish (corned beef), drinks, plates, utensils, etc. Please bring a dish to share and your own chair. The color of the day is "GREEN", so plan your dog's ensemble (and yours!) accordingly. This is a fun day to spend with other club members and their Irish. Everyone is Irish on St. Patrick's Day !!

In the past, it has gotten quite warm and the top priority is to make sure the dogs are comfortable. Please bring a 6-foot leather lead for your dog; do NOT bring a flexi/retractable lead. Our dogs need to be on their best behavior and under control at all times. This can be a very long walk for our red senior citizens, so be aware of their needs during the parade.

We'll leave the parking area by 8:55 to walk to the staging area. The officials like us to be in place by 9:30 am, because step off is 10:30 am. Once again we are marching with the Ancient Order of Hibernians.

Remember:

DO NOT bring a flexi leash – you will not be allowed to march in the parade with a retractable leash.

DO bring a 6-foot leather lead.

DO wear your ISCSD T-shirt or sweatshirt so you can be identified as a member of the ISCSD. Only club members are allowed to march with us in the parade.

DO dress your Irish appropriately for the day

Rattlesnakes can be found almost anywhere, and their bites are quite common, dangerous and usually very expensive to treat. Our avoidance training teaches dogs to recognize and stay away from the scent, sound and sight of rattlesnakes they become aware of.

The safety and comfort of your dog is our highest priority! The training takes place in a controlled environment using a remote training-collar system adjusted specifically to each dog's temperament, personality and physical response characteristics. We use only the minimum level of stimulation to produce the desired education. Yearly training is recommended to refresh and strengthen your dog's rattlesnakes awareness.

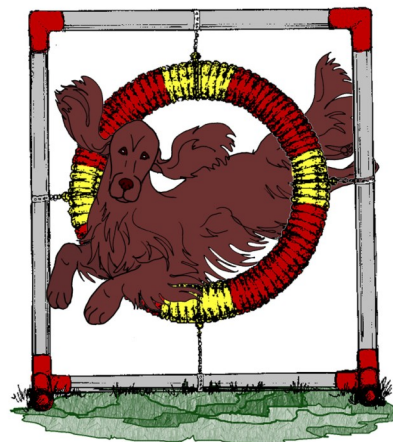
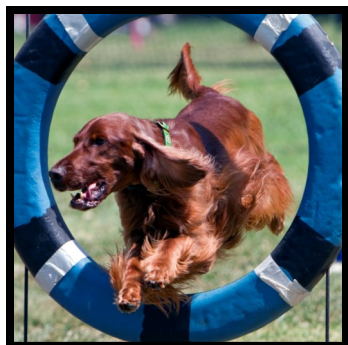

BOARD & GENERAL MEETING MINUTES 1/8/2015

Irish Setter Club of San Diego

BOARD MEETING: called to order at 7:00 PM. Members present: Chris Cohen-Richards, Kathy Whiteis, Alice Borg, Rickard Borg, Robert Rez, Sherry Rez, Jill Merrifield, Linda Kenan, Cathy Dever, Alexis Heath, and Valerie Mahoney. Business postponed to General Meeting. Adjourned at 7:03 PM.

GENERAL MEETING: called to order at 7:04 PM.

Minutes from the December 13, 2014 meeting were read and corrections made. The motion to accept corrected minutes made by Linda Kenan, seconded by Sherry Rez.

OFFICERS REPORTS:

- President - Chris Cohen-Richards – See committee reports.
 - Vice President – Rickard Borg – No report.
 - Treasurer - Valerie Mahoney – The treasurer's report for December and the cumulative report for the year were printed out and provided to attendees by Val. The club is \$700 dollars positive for this year. Familiarizing himself with the treasurer's report, Chris observed all in all, the club has \$10,000. Interest rates were briefly discussed but due to the low market return, have not really ever investigated before. One CD is for seven months and one is for 12 months. The club rescue balance is contained within the \$10,000 figure.
- Secretary – Jill Merrifield – No report. However, attendees discussed the need to inform AKC and ISCA of the new officers. The secretary needs to update the address and contact information using a link on each website for this purpose. Also, there is prior club information that needs to be picked up from Madeline for use by the new secretary.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

- Newsletter (Chris Cohen-Richards) – The newsletter have been e-mailed to members, but has not yet been placed on the internet site yet. Chris will post it this coming weekend.
 - Facebook (Chris Cohen-Richards) – There are 143 likes currently.
 - Membership (Valerie Mahoney) - We have had 19 renewals and 10 non-renewals so far. No applications were received.
- Rescue (Sherry Rez) – No report. Cathy Whiteis brought up that she received an email from some other club concerning the need someone has to "foster" a dog for two months while she moves. Cathy threw the topic out in case anyone was interested in helping out. Contact Kathy if interested in fostering this dog.

OLD BUSINESS

- Trophy update (Linda Kenan) Sent out a letter soliciting for donations and will send out follow-up request letters. We are not half way to the needed coverage for trophies yet. Linda will send a third letter as well if needed. There were discussions regarding the Premium list. Chris will give Eileen an ad to place in the premium list regarding our specialty shows.
 - 2015 second show – Is handled. Trophies have been bought and paid for, coming in under the \$800 budget allowed. Nice job.
 - 2016 final selection and budget for both shows was discussed with Roger Kibby trophies as a possibility. Linda contacted them for our current upcoming show, but Kibby did not get back to her timely so she went another way. Chris brought up the consideration of using our logo for a carved trophy – similar in idea only to the Kibby trophy. Chris will check on prices for different carved pieces and let everyone know. Kathy stated shipping for major trophies is very expensive.
 - The club wants to provide a list of desirable judges to Silver Bay for future consideration. If Silver Bay requests judges our club suggests (who will draw a large number of entries), then our club would not have to support the judge's fees indendently. Judges costs run between \$200 to \$500 each. None of the club's preferred judges were being used by Silver Bay this year, which is why our club was forced to hire them and pay 100 percent of the costs. Depending on whether (or not) Silver Bay selects and funds the judges for the 2016 show will determine how much we have to spend on trophies.
- If our club needs to pay for the judges then \$1,000 for the morning trophies is too much to spend. We have been spending about \$1,500 on our trophies, which is high and does not include ribbons. Valerie reported that for last February's shows the costs were \$1,300 for trophies and \$300 for ribbons (both shows). In 2013 we paid \$1,800 and 2014 costs were \$1,700. We run about 50% collection regarding donations for trophies.

BOARD & GENERAL MEETING MINUTES 1/8/2015

- If our club needs to pay for the judges then \$1,000 for the morning trophies is too much to spend. We have been spending about \$1,500 on our trophies, which is high and does not include ribbons. Valerie reported that for last February's shows the costs were \$1,300 for trophies and \$300 for ribbons (both shows). In 2013 we paid \$1,800 and 2014 costs were \$1,700. We run about 50% collection regarding donations for trophies.
 - Kathy brought in large coffee mugs with Irish setters on them that she found at Home Goods - she purchased 20 of them (all she could find in several stores). These are going to be used for one of the 2016 shows. Club members will look for similar mugs in their local Home Goods Stores.
 - Sherry brought up that "Dexters" will put together a gift basket for the raffle and would like to somehow advertise their store. Sherry will go ahead and get back with Dexters about getting that gift basket for our upcoming show's raffle.
 - We need to make a decision about next year's show so Silver Bay can give us feedback. Members will consider which judges they thought were good and provide feedback at the next meeting - club favorite judges in all areas who will draw an entry. This list will be given to Silver Bay for consideration.
 - The club will move forward on the budget of \$1000. Valerie proposed a budget of \$1,000 for Kathy Erickson to do the 2016 trophies. Kathy seconded the motion. All agreed - No opposition.
 - Emergency vet document - Chris will add this information to be included in the club new member information and attach it to the next e-mail.
- Banquet location - The Marie Calendars in La Mesa has always worked well with the club in the past so we will stick with them for this year. Valerie will make the reservations.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Form show committee - We will have the pre-show meeting at Sherry and Robert's house on Monday February 2nd at 7:00 pm. Everybody who wants to attend should. Chris will send out a group e-mail to remind everyone. There have been some problems with Rickard's e-mail address and sent items bouncing back. Rickard provided his e-mail again as rborglaw@aol.com alice.s.borg@gmail.com, also giving margegillingham@aol.com (his assistant's contact) as an emergency e-mail address.

ISCSD DONATION LETTER:

Chris brought up that we should have a generic donation letter to hand out or e-mail to someone requesting donations. We have also asked vendors to contribute. Dawn Secor will bring an item for the raffle. Do we want to purchase a big item for the raffle? The unanimous vote was yes. Linda will check for good buys on line and get a similar soft side crate (a 500) again like last year - it was a popular item.

REC CENTER ATTENDEES:

The club discussed the need for one of the members to attend the bi-monthly rec center meetings as the club representative. Alexis attended the January meeting representing the club but had nothing of note to report. Rec center meetings are held every other month: Jan, Mar, May, July, September, and November on the first Monday of the month at 7:00 pm (date changes are holiday dependent). However attendees will need to sign in at the back of the room (same room our club meets in) using the sign-in sheet on the table. Sign in for the ISCSD club and who you are (board member or officer). The following are volunteers to attend: March will be Sherry Rez; May will be Jill Merrifield; Chris will be July, Alice will be September and Alice will be November.

ST. PATRICKS DAY PARADE:

- March 14, 2015
- Who can help Lynn - Alexis will do the corned beef, bread and condiments (as Madeline did before). Individuals will let everybody else know what they are bringing.

HOUSE OF IRELAND REQUEST FOR MARCH 15, 2015 @2PM

International cottages, Balboa Park - Chris forwarded the e-mail he received from the requestor and it was brought up at the meeting. Allison will bring a dog but not talk. Valerie might be willing, but wants someone else to go as well. Information obtained from Rickard states the "Borg gang" will appear and cover the event for the club.

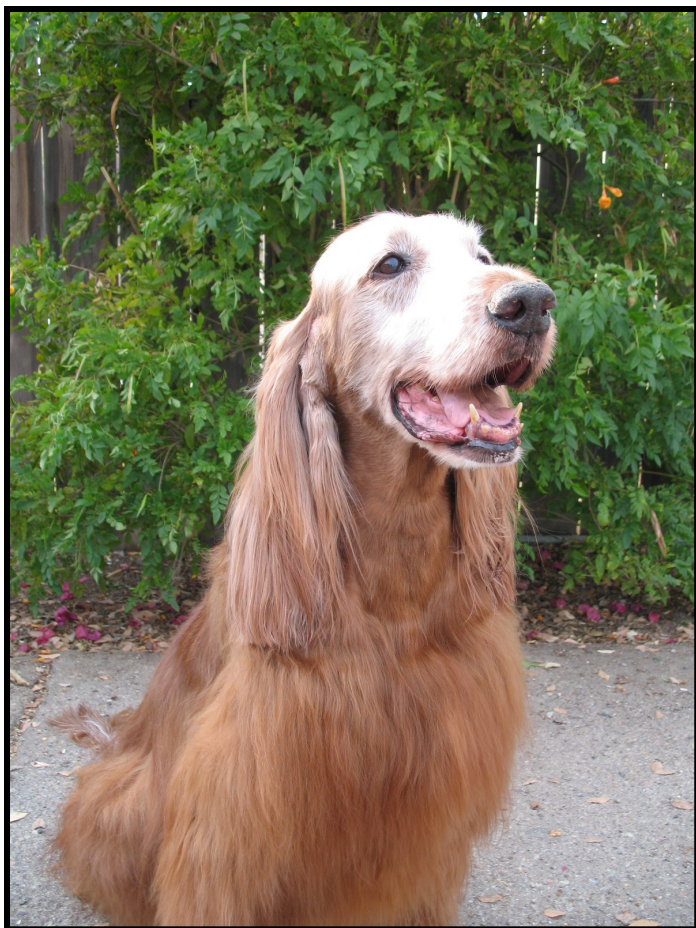
