**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telephoned or telegraphed entries cannot be accepted. Entries without fees cannot be accepted.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC entry forms are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by telegram prior to the close of entries. Changes which are received on the telephone are unacceptable.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS on entry blanks, and for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY & SCHEDULE OF JUDGING TIME will be sent to the address on the Official AKC Entry Form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule of Judging seven days prior to the show, the Show Secretary should be contacted.

Effective for all shows held on or after July 1, 1991, dogs may be moved FROM ONE DIVISION OF THE PUPPY CLASS TO ANOTHER or a CORRECTION TO THE SEX OF A DOG may be made, or a dog, which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show. (American Kennel Club Rules, Chapter 14, Section 6.)

DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately after unless required for further judging.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The club and/or its Show Secretary will not be responsible for, and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

THE SHOW-GIVING CLUB, THE SHOW SECRETARY, their agents or employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of their parents or guardians.

No tents, large umbrellas, or equipment of any sort will be allowed within 10 feet of any ring. Grooming must be done away from the judging rings in areas designated by the Club.

ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, in season, excused by the veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the show committee. If because of weather, riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee(s) will be made.

This Club and Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. This Club and Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agent entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, nor for entering the same dog twice.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations."

NOVICE JUNIOR - For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old and who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member club show.

OPEN JUNIOR - For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member club show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE - For boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old and who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member club show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE - For boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old and who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member club show.

NOVICE SENIOR - For boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old and who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member club show.

OPEN SENIOR - For boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member club show.

MASTER - This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

Each dog handled in a Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the breed or obedience classes at this show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitutions must be made one half hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship classes at the show. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including the corresponding step and half relations or by a member of the Junior Handlers household. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows and Obedience Trials. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a breed judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed or excused by the veterinarian for the protection of other dogs at the show, or for the protection of the excused dog, may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.

JUNIOR HANDLERS who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is EARLIER.

Competition is required for Best Junior Handler.

Winning of first place in an Open Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on eligibility requirements for limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved to date by AKC, write to the American Kennel Club, Show Plans, 5580 Centerview Dr., Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606.

Junior Handler's must include their AKC Junior Handler identification number on the entry blank. You may obtain your number by calling the AKC (919) 816-3776.

## VERSATILITY CERTIFICATE TEST

The Versatility Test for Conformation is offered in accordance with the Irish Setter Club of America's Versatility Certificate requirements. Dogs participating in this event need not be entered in one of the conformation classes at this show. Dogs must be 6 months of age or older to enter. The entry fee is **\$15 per dog. ENTRIES MUST BE MADE ON A SEPARATE ENTRY FORM.** A ribbon signifying PASS shall be awarded to those dogs who participate in and pass this test. **Three (3) passes under three (3) different judges are required for the ISCA Versatility Certificate.** This is not an official AKC event.
